
Why is Breastfeeding Important?

 AAP recommends exclusive breastfeeding for at least the first 6 months of life.

- Breastfeeding protects children from illness, lowers obesity risk, contributes to brain development, mother and child bonding, and has economic benefits.
- In-hospital exclusive breastfeeding rate is 63% (CDPH, 2014). At 6 months this rate can often drop to 15% (WIC, 2014).

F5VC's Breastfeeding Project

Exclusive breastfeeding for the first 6 months of a child's life is the norm in Ventura County.
